ORDER

Under the Presiding Justice's Administrative Order No. 2013-07, these matters were consolidated before the Honorable Brian P. Stern. In accordance with this Court's January 6, 2014 Decision, it is hereby:

ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED

1. The Rhode Island State Labor Relations Board's (the "SLRB") September 27, 2013 Decision and Order in Case No. ULP-6088 (the "SLRB's Decision and Order") are affirmed, except with respect to Paragraph 5 and Paragraph 7 of the SLRB's Order, which the Court hereby vacates.
2. In accordance with the foregoing, the SLRB's Petition to Enforce its Decision and Order is granted in part and denied in part.
3. Based on the limited and important issue of a potential conflict with the Rhode Island Supreme Court's May 10, 2013 Order in Town of North Kingstown v. Int'l Ass'n of Firefighters, 65 A.3d 480 (R.I. 2013), the Court's January 6, 2014 Decision is stayed until such time as the Rhode Island Supreme Court has the opportunity to review whether or not this stay should remain in effect or be vacated or by the Court.
4. The Town of North Kingstown's requests for Declaratory Judgment in Counts I and III of its First Amended Complaint in PC-2013-4261 is denied;
5. The Town of North Kingstown's request for Declaratory Judgment; requests for preliminary and permanent injunctions; and request for attorney's fees and costs in Count IV of its First Amended Complaint in PC-2013-4261 is denied;


6. The Town of North Kingstown's requests for Declaratory Judgment and preliminary and permanent injunctions in Count V of its First Amended Complaint in PC-2013-4261 is denied;
7. In accordance with the foregoing and subject to the foregoing stay, Final Judgment shall enter in Case. Nos WM-2013-0516 and PC-2013-4261.


FINAL JUDGMENT


